To be eligible for this award, students must be:

- an above average student with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale

The awardee will be notified by May 14, 2021 and the scholarship presentation will be held on or around June 1, 2021.

For entry and consideration for the MidwestHR Scholarship award for 2021, please complete and submit the following:

Please complete the three page application form. All pages should be completed neatly and legibly. On page two, you will be asked to document the following:

- Service Activities: Applicants should list all service activities participated in during your High School career. Please include your role in the activity along with the name and contact information for a person that can verify each activity.
- Leadership Positions: List all leadership positions held during your High School career. Please include the name and contact information for a person that can verify your participation.

You will also be required to include/attach the following:

- **Essay:** Applicants are asked to write a 300-word essay describing their high school leadership experiences and how those experiences will help the students attain their life goals.
- **Current High School Transcript:** Transcript should include all years of attendance and indicate your accumulative grade point average (GPA).
- Copy of the Letter of Admission/Acceptance to a 2-year or 4-year accredited college/university.
- Letter of Recommendation: Applicants are encouraged to include one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach, employer, etc. (no relatives) explaining why you, as the applicant, should be awarded with this scholarship.

Please make sure to read the Scholarship Guidelines and sign the Statement of Accuracy on the final page of the application. Incomplete or illegible applications or applications that do not meet eligibility criteria will not be considered for this scholarship.

All application materials must be submitted together and in their entirety by **May 1, 2021** to be considered. Applications will be accepted via mail, email or fax at the addresses listed below. - The applicant must be a graduating high school senior, in good standing, accepted to an accredited college/university in the Fall semester of the scholarship year.
- The applicant must be a child of an active MidwestHR client company employee on the date of application and when the scholarship is awarded. If employment status is terminated on or before the scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be forfeited.
- The winner, and their parent(s), will be requested to attend an award ceremony. The location of the ceremony will be at the MidwestHR corporate office (Woodridge, IL) or alternatively at the MidwestHR client company (if outside of the Chicagoland area).
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college/university on behalf of the student. If acceptance of admission is revoked, rescinded, terminated, delayed, or does not occur in the Fall of the scholarship year, for any reason, the scholarship will be revoked.
